STUDY COMMITMENTS

Our online courses are a mix of 'flexible self-guided learning', and 'real time interaction' online sessions with the lecturer and study peers.

You will need to allocate approximately nine hours per unit per week. Three hours for self-guided learning of the unit content, and six hours for further reading, assessments and online sessions with the lecturer and fellow students.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To study the Bachelor of Theology you must have successfully completed the Victorian Certificate of Education in an Australian secondary school, or equivalent.

The Bachelor of Theology comprises 24 standard undergraduate units. The cost is \$2,109* per unit. All our courses qualify for Austudy and FEE-HELP government loan assistance. The cost of each unit does not have to be paid up front, you can spread the cost out over the duration of the course.
